

IKAEGENG COAL-TO-LIQUIDS PROJECT

REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL: BOL/RFP/2023-24-11

PUBLIC PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP FOR THE DESIGN, BUILD, FINANCE, OPERATE, MAINTAIN AND TRANSFER OF THE IKAEGENG COAL-TO-LIQUID FUELS FACILITY

The Botswana Government, through the Ministry of Minerals and Energy (MME) and Botswana Oil Limited (BOL), a government owned company, is seeking proposals from competent Developers to design, build, finance, operate, maintain and transfer the Ikaegeng Coal-to-Liquid Fuels (CTL) Facility, to be built in Botswana on a Public Private Partnership (PPP) basis.

The Facility will be underpinned by an off-take agreement, whereby BOL will purchase some of the petroleum products for sale into the Botswana market. The facility will be sited in Botswana, using Botswana coal as input material.

The project will be tendered on a turnkey basis and BOL is looking for a single consortium to provide all aspects of the project: technical, design, environmental, construction, commissioning and financing under a PPP agreement. The project also entails operating and maintaining the Facility for a specified period, and ultimately transferring it back to the Botswana Government at the end of the operation and maintenance period.

The process outlined below is open to all interested parties and registration as a contractor is not an eligibility requirement to participate.

The procurement process will take place on a secure electronic procurement platform which will require registration by Respondents.

SECURING OF THE RFP DOCUMENT

Request for Proposal (RFP) documents will be made available only to those who have:

- expressed an interest in the project;
- signed and returned a Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA) and an Integrity Agreement; and
- paid the RFP Document Fee.

The steps below should be followed to acquire the RFP document:

STEP 1: Send an expression of interest email to:

STEP 2: RFP letter:

A letter will be sent by BOL to all parties which have expressed an interest. The letter will contain the following:

- details of when and how the RFP can be collected;
- the NDA to be signed by all Bidders;
- the Integrity Agreement to be signed by all Bidders;
- the RFP Document Fee required; and
- the names and contact details of persons to be contacted for clarification and for collection of the RFP.

STEP 3: Completion of documents:

On receipt of the letter from BOL, the required documents should be completed and the RFP Document Fee paid. The completed documents and proof of payment should be sent through to BOL by email to the address supplied.

STEP 4: Receive registration email from BOL and complete registration by following the prescribed steps to access the procurement portal.

STEP 5: Access RFP document on the procurement portal once registration is complete.

SUBMISSION AND EVALUTION CRITERIA

All requirements regarding submission of the RFP, the bid process being used, and the evaluation criteria are set out in the RFP document and no other documentation will be required.
